

Mouse CD228/MFI2 Protein

Description

Source	Recombinant Mouse CD228/MFI2 Protein is expressed from HEK293 with His tag at the C-Terminus. It contains Val20-Cys709.
Accession	Q9R0R1
Molecular Weight	The protein has a predicted MW of 77.30 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 78-80 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per μg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE > 95% as determined by HPLC

Formulation and Storage

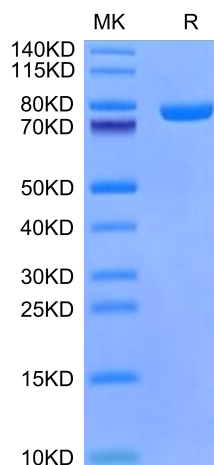
Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22 μm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 $\mu\text{g}/\text{ml}$ is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt. -20 to -80°C for 3-6 months in unopened state after reconstitution. 2-8°C for 2-7 days after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

Melanotransferrin (MTf) or melanoma tumor antigen p97 is a transferrin (Tf) homolog that is found predominantly bound to the cell membrane via a glycosyl phosphatidylinositol anchor. The molecule is a member of the Tf superfamily and binds iron through a single high-affinity iron(III)-binding site.

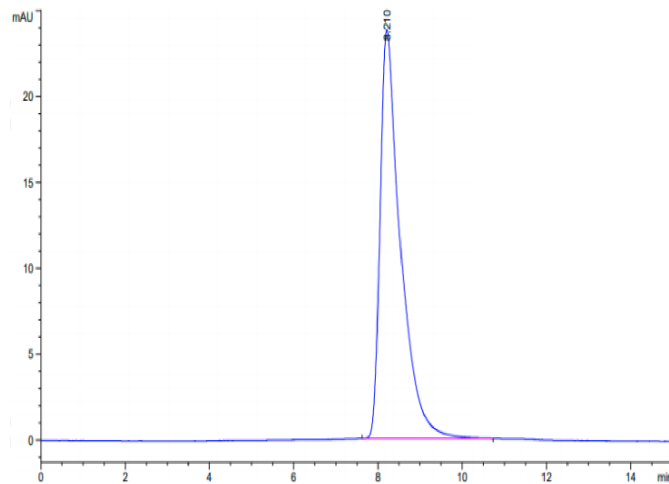
Tris-Bis PAGE
